ARTICLE 1 INTRODUCTION

CÔTE BASQUE ÉCHECS and AROKI

organize the

2nd International Chess Open Côte Basque Bayonne

ARTICLE 2 LAWS

- The Laws of Chess adopted at the 88th FIDE Congress at Goynuk, Antalya, Turkey coming into force on 1 January 2018 are applied,
- Accelerated pairings can be applied,
- Official pairings are published 30 minutes before each round,
- Before 20 moves played, the consent of the arbiter is needed for players to offer or agree to a draw.
- Any prospective participant who has not arrived at the venue before the time scheduled (10:30) for the drawing of lots shall be excluded from the tournament unless he shows up at the venue in time before a pairing of another round.
There is no bye: a player not playing the first round can be paired for the next round with 0 point.

ARTICLE 4 RATE OF PLAY

Rate of play is 90 minutes + 30 seconds per move.

The default time is 30 minutes.

Any player who arrives at the chessboard after the default time shall lose the game.

A player who is absent without notifying the arbiter will be considered as withdrawn, unless the absence is explained with acceptable arguments before the next pairing is published.

The result of a game has to be written down by the winner at the arbiter's table.

If an error notification of an incorrect result is made after the publishing of the pairings of the next round, the correction will be made after the tournament for submission to rating evaluation only. Otherwise it will affect the next pairing to be done.

ARTICLE 5 ENTRY FEE

Adults: 45 €

Young (-20 years): 22 €

Grandmasters and International masters is free only if they have confirmed their inscription 48 hours before the start of the tournament.

ARTICLE 6 TIE BREAK

In case of equality in points, the following system will be applied:

1 – Buchholz Cut 1

2 – Cumulative

3 – Performance

ARTICLE 7 PRIZES

The list of prizes will be published before the end of round 4.

ARTICLE 8 ARBITER
